Please read carefully before commencing work and retain for future reference.


SAFETY INFORMATION

- * The supply cable runs through the inside of this product, take care not to place undue stress on the cable whilst unpacking to prevent the possibility of a poor connection.
- * If you are in any doubt consult a person competent to give advice on the assembly of electrical equipment.
- * Always be sure to use the correct type and wattage of bulbs as indicated on the fitting. Do not exceed stated wattage.
- * If the external flexible cable of the lamp is damaged it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- * When changing the bulb, always unplug from the mains and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of used bulbs carefully.
- * **CAUTION: This product is fitting with tension springs. Avoid injury! Fingers and hands can be pinched.**
- * Do not over stretch the spring and take care not to cause injury.

FINISH NOTE: The new Antique Chrome finish on the Osaka range is a combination of the standard electroplating process with a 'special' treatment applied by hand to achieve the unique matt finish. As the final coating and finishing process is applied manually, each product may have a slightly different patina and as a result is unique. This manual application can therefore result in slight variations in the depth of colour and finish, which is a natural part of this individual process.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unpack the product and remove all packaging. Be careful not to scratch the surface of the poles whilst removing the plastic wrapping. Also ensure base does not get scratched by the ends of the poles or the plug.
2. Lay the product out on a flat surface, which has been previously covered with a soft cloth to avoid damage to the flooring and surface of the product.
3. Fit the short stem at the end of main body of the floor / table lamp onto the base post whilst making sure the locating slot is aligned with screw hole.
4. Secure the short stem into position by screwing the finial into position, Ensure the finial is fully tightened. ①
5. Fit the tension spring onto the lower support post then attach the other end of tension spring onto the support post of the upper support post. ② **Do not use sharp or metal implement as this may damage the product.**
6. Where included, attach the adjustment handle onto the shade by compressing it and fitting it into the shade. You may need to push the handle further into the shade to enable it to fit correctly into shade rim. ③ **Take care whilst handling the shade as the rim may be sharp in places.**
7. Carefully remove any packaging material surrounding the lighting head whilst taking care not to scratch the surfaces.
8. Remove the shade ring from the bulb holder then fit the shade and secure into position using the shade ring. ④
9. Fit the bulb: type and wattage as indicated on the product. ⑤ **The wattage indicated must not be exceeded.**
10. Adjust the lighting head as required the secure into position by tightening the locking levers, take care not to over tighten.
11. Your table / floor lamp is now ready for use.
